Our meetings are online and in person.

Be a survivor with demonstratively sufficient personal healing to facilitate a group safely

Have the ability to create psychologically safe spaces for all that facilitates sharing, reflection and learning.

Act authentically and consistently, developing self-awareness by seeking feedback from others.

Be reflective, empathetic and have exceptional listening skills

Use discretion and judgement in dealing with confidential and sensitive issues, but be unafraid to engage where necessary with emotive or controversial topics.

Be able to demonstrate the experience you bring to the role. It may be from your work, other voluntary roles or your life experience

Be willing to be part of the team

Volunteering with us

We require every volunteer to provide a CV with complete job history for safeguarding purposes. Please attach your CV to your application. We can offer a blank CV template if you need one.

Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) Checks

We require all volunteers to provide a Basic DBS check. If your role will include any unsupervised contact with children, young people or regulated activities with adults we will ask you to consent to the relevant Standard or Enhanced DBS. This is to ensure we safeguard everyone we work with.

You do not have to consent to these checks being carried out, but if you don't consent we may change or end your role with us.

Data protection and Confidentiality:

The information that you provide on this form and that we receive from your referees will be used to complete your appointment and ensure our practice is safe.

Information will be shared confidentially within Reshapers only with your named supervisor, the administrator and the Directors as required.
